**AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 9
OF
THE TOWN OF GLEN ECHO CODE**

WHEREAS, Article 23A, Section 2B of the Maryland Code, and Section 2-96, of the Montgomery County Code each state that any municipal corporation may, by ordinance, request and authorize the County to administer or enforce any municipal legislation and upon the enactment of such an ordinance, the County may administer or enforce the municipal legislation on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed; and

WHEREAS, The Town Council of the Town of Glen Echo wishes to clarify and amend Section 9.1 of Article 9, of the Ordinances of the Town of Glen Echo, "APPLICABILITY OF COUNTY LEGISLATION," so that the intent and spirit of Article 23A, Section 2B of the Maryland Code and Section 2-96 of the Montgomery County Code are given their full effect within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE:

1. **Be it enacted** by the Town Council of the Town of Glen Echo that Section 9.1 of Article 9 "APPLICABILITY OF COUNTY LEGISLATION" of the Ordinances of the Town of Glen Echo is hereby repealed and deleted in its entirety.

2. **Be it further enacted** by the Town Council that a new Section 9.1 of Article 9 "APPLICABILITY OF COUNTY LEGISLATION" is hereby adopted to read as follows:

9.1 Exemption from County Code

Except for the Chapters listed below, the provisions of the Montgomery County Code, as amended, are hereby adopted and shall apply and be enforced within the corporate limits of the Town of Glen Echo. Any amendments to such Chapters shall become effective within the Town to the extent not disapproved by the Town Council by Ordinance. Pursuant to the authority granted to municipal corporations by laws of the State of Maryland and Montgomery County, the Town of Glen Echo hereby exempts itself from the following Chapters of the Montgomery County Code:
